ACTION REQUIRED FROM BANKS

Consumption Loans for Houses:

- Ground floor houses in 179 sachivalayams: **Rs 50,000** loan with a **36-month repayment period** and a **3-month moratorium**.
- First floor and above houses in 179 sachivalayams: **Rs 25,000** loan with a **36-month repayment period** and a **3-month moratorium**.

Shops, Commercial Establishments, and MSMEs:

- Banks have agreed to **reschedule payments for 12 months**; the government is requesting a **24-month rescheduling**.
- The government is also requesting **additional working capital without further collateral**.

Agriculture Loans:

- **Short-term crop loans** to be rescheduled for **5 years**, with a **12-month moratorium**.
- **Agriculture term loans** should have instalments rescheduled.
- **Fresh crop loans** to be issued as per farmers' needs
